WHY: Your design could be featured on the FRONT COVER of the yearbook! The top (4) runner-up's will be featured on the back cover.

HOW: Make sure your design fits completely within the 9-1/2" x 7" border of the template. Please note that any artwork which comes very close to the border may be lost.

IMPORTANT!!! Please design your artwork in portrait format..NOT landscape.

Rules and Fine Print.....important! Please, please, please read:

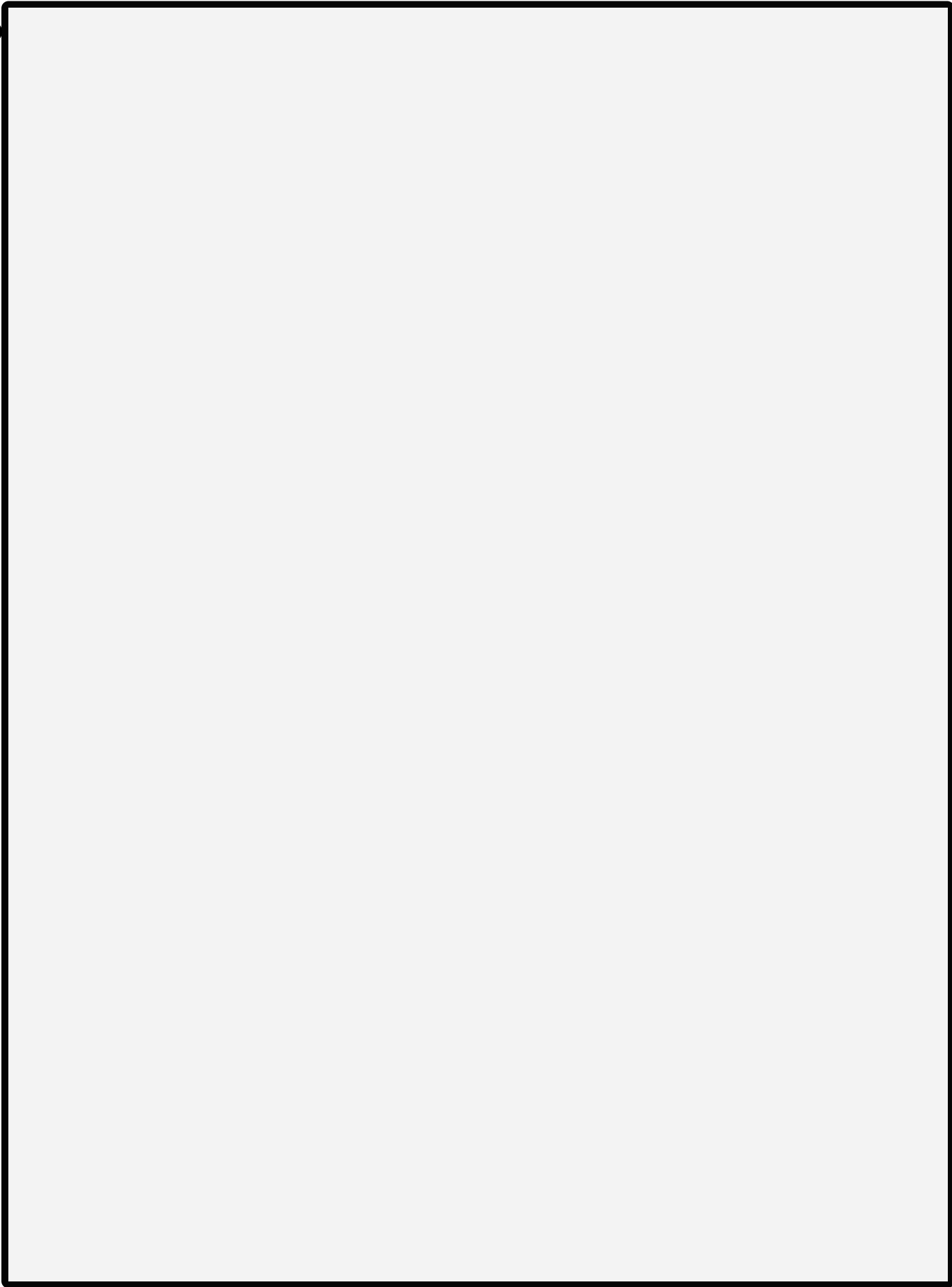
- Your artwork may not be returned
- Do not autograph your work. Winners will be asked to autograph their work before it is sent off to production
- Write your NAME and TEACHER's name on the back of your entry in PENCIL, write it somewhere NOT directly on the back of your artwork--it shows through when scanning for the publisher!
- A panel of impartial judges will rank the designs. ID of the artists will be hidden during judging.
- If you need another template, simply create your own using a standard, WHITE 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper and draw a 7"W x 9-1/2"H rectangle. Portrait NOT Landscape
- PLEASE make sure that your artwork is within the rectangle. Especially if you have words, lettering or anything important to you that you do not want cut off or important to your design. Artwork can go over the edges if it is part of your design.
- PLEASE check your entry for spelling! Your entry may be eliminated if it has spelling errors.
