Winter Percussion uses a variety of drums and other percussion instruments in a musical performance of drill movements and precision teamwork. Winter Guard units perform to a variety of musical genres, incorporating dance, acrobatics, precision drill and the spinning and tossing of rifles, flags and sabers in dynamic routines. Both competitions will have units ranging from the fairly small to world class level – all are amazing performances; it's not to be missed!
